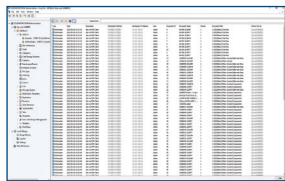

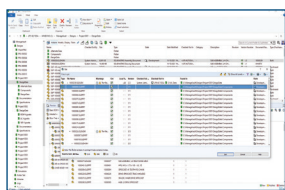


1 Enhanced File Tracking

Improve data security through more detailed audit trail information and file tracking.

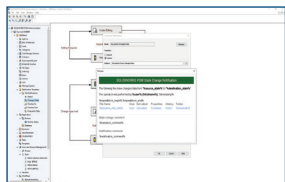


2 Improved File Transfer Security

Increase data security when files are in transit.

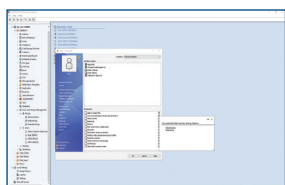


3 Better Visualization

Streamline notification information and improve the user experience.

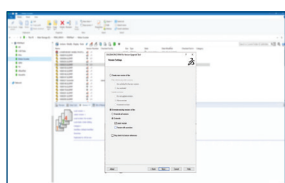


4 Enhanced User and Group Controls
